# A total of 18 Learning Objectives for the "BeConfident Five Elements of Comprehensive Development"

## Confident Expression Element

- Facilitate Children to practise English Phonics effectively, providing a good foundation for reading and writing
- The pronunciation of a single word is correctly expressed, knowing how to read a word and love reading and telling stories.
- The children will be confident in English conversation, no longer only speak single words in conversation

## Overcoming Challenges with Positive Attitude Element

Training Activities:

- Logical reasoning and Logic-Maths exercises
- Observation exercises, the children observe carefully and they could make agile reactions
- The improvement of the attention span, the children could listen instructions carefully and be more attentive

## Physical Breakthrough Element

- Individual or Group Gross and Fine motor skills training activities
- Small fun games to encourage children to make breakthroughs in handling difficulties
- Improving children's self-care ability

## Moral Education Social Development Element

- Cultivation of politeness, courtesy and etiquette
- Activities are designed to let children accept failure
- Train the children to be more brave and face failures positively, they will be more willing to share and be patient to wait

- Draw and Tell exercise
- Festival Singing
- Simple writing activities, the children will not be afraid to write

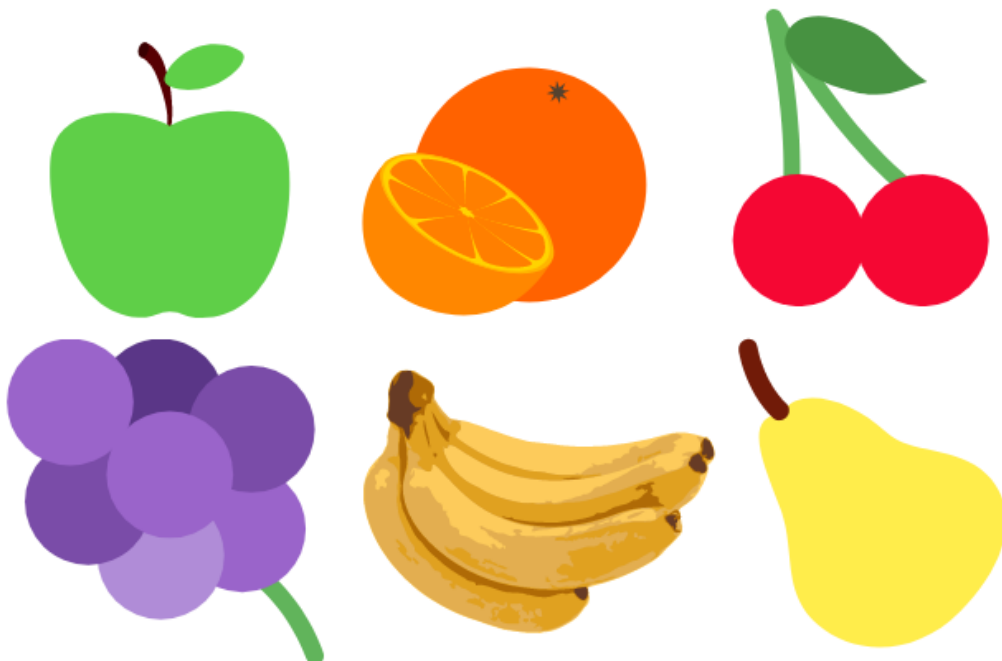
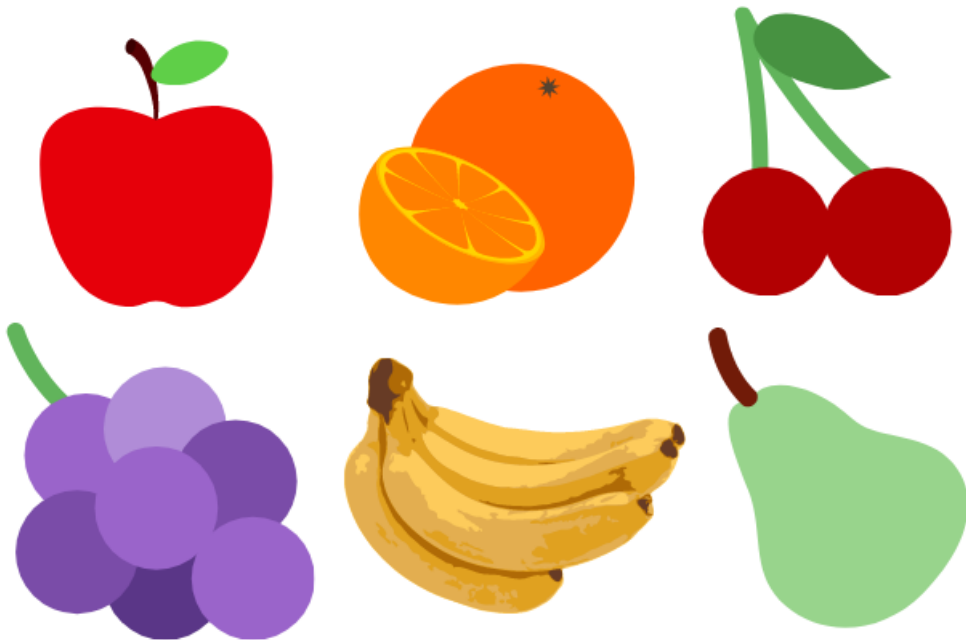
- The children can recognize basic English words

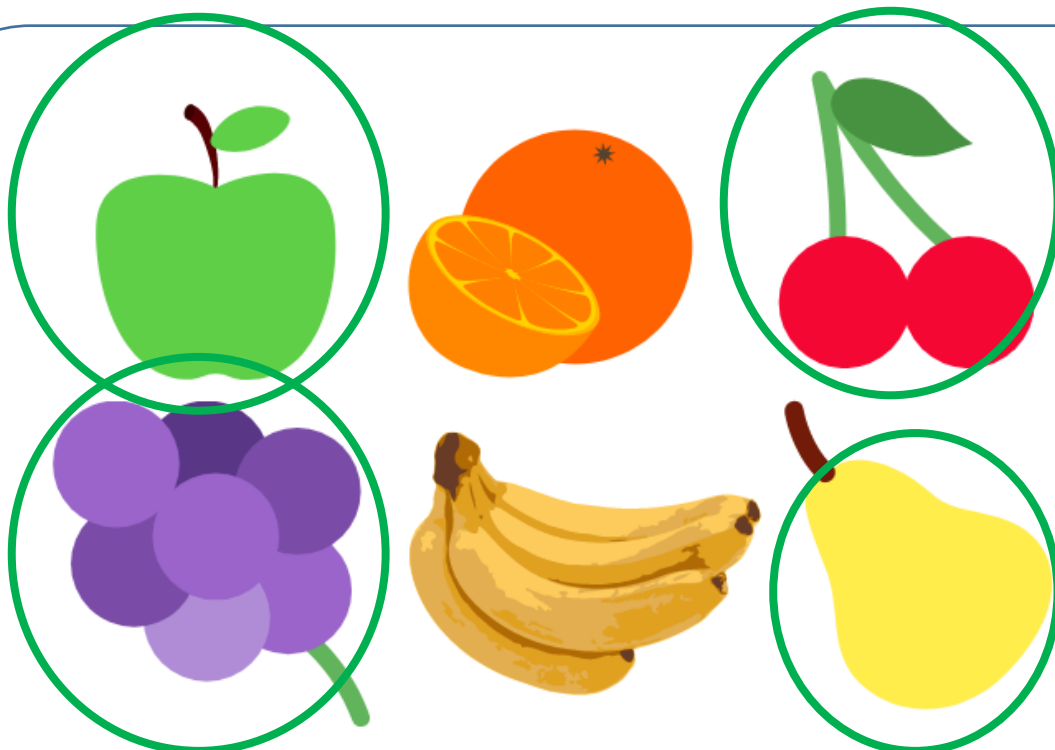
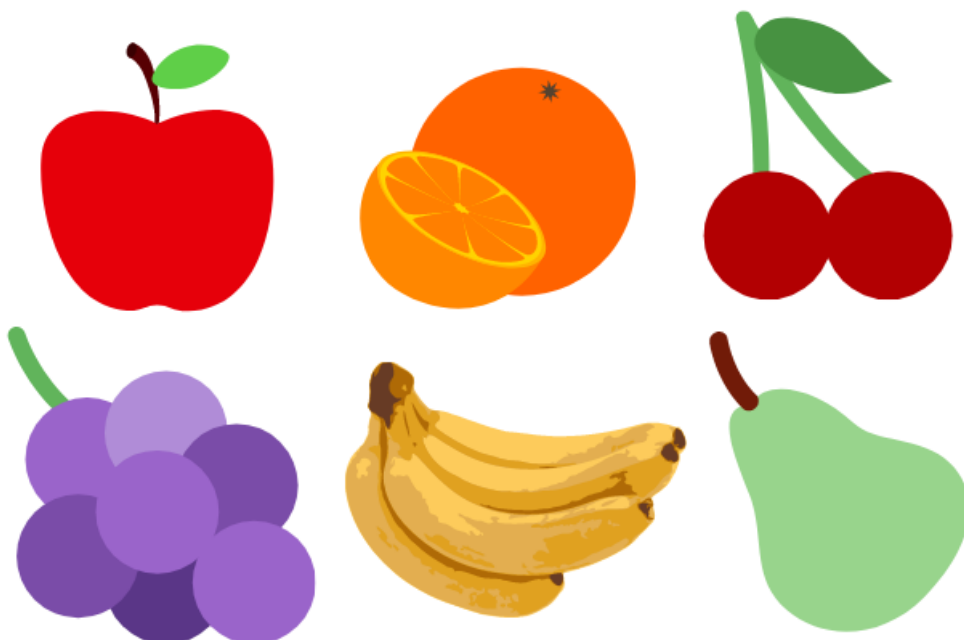
- The children can recognize and read short sentences
